



THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

Lake of the Woods Women's Walleye Tournament

Please follow the steps in the order listed below.

Section 1 explains how to download the app and register in the app.

Section 2 explains how to register with LOTWWWT and pay your tournament fees.

Before You Begin

- Review Rules & Regulations that can be found on the website
- A Gmail account to complete the LOTWWWT Google Form
- The eTournament Fishing app downloaded and installed on your phone
- A headshot of each team member
- The name of your driver, if applicable
- Mailing addresses
- Email addresses
- Phone numbers
- Birthdates
- Boat make and motor horsepower
- The division you are entering
- The ability to send an e-transfer for registration fees

SECTION 1: DOWNLOADING, INSTALLING, AND REGISTERING IN THE APP

STEP ONE: DOWNLOAD AND INSTALL THE eTOURNAMENT FISHING APP

Only one team member is required to download the app. However, it is strongly recommended that both team members have the app in case a backup is needed on tournament day.

Once you create your account, complete your profile. This information will pre-populate when you register for the tournament.

STEP TWO: ALLOW THE REQUIRED PERMISSIONS

This is important for the app to work properly during the tournament.

STEP THREE: LOG IN TO THE APP AND SELECT THE ANGLER ROLE

STEP FOUR: SEARCH FOR THE LOTWWWT EVENT IN THE APP

In the tournament search, enter “Lake of the Woods Women’s Walleye Tournament.” You will then see the two event options listed.

STEP FIVE: CHOOSE THE CORRECT EVENT IN THE APP

You must register for the correct event in the app:

1. Lake of the Woods Women’s Walleye Tournament - No Driver
2. Lake of the Woods Women’s Walleye Tournament - With Driver

Please note: You do not need to subscribe to the app until the tournament. The subscription is purchased directly through the app.

If you are pre-fishing within 30 days of the tournament, you may wish to subscribe at that time. The app includes a fish log that allows you to track where fish were caught by recording your catch coordinates.

If you subscribe early, please make sure your subscription is still active at tournament time.

SECTION 2: REGISTERING WITH LOTWWWT AND PAYING TOURNAMENT FEES
